Pre-Trip Checklist

- It is important to wear light, breathable clothing, as the climate is generally hot and humid.
- Be sure to dress in layers when going out in the evenings, as temperatures can drop significantly. Additionally, be sure to bring a pair of comfortable walking shoes for excursions or sightseeing. As the terrain can be quite rugged, it is also recommended that you bring a good pair of hiking boots if you are planning on more rigorous hikes and trails.
- It is also essential that you bring plenty of water with you and always have some on hand. Bottled water is widely available from local stores and supermarkets. Make sure to stay hydrated during your time in Ghana as dehydration can set in quickly due to the heat and humidity.
- You may also encounter sandy roads, so protect your eyes with sunglasses and carry a hat to guard yourself against the sun.
- Don't forget to bring sunscreen, as well as a camera and power bank, in case you want to capture your memorable moments and keep your devices charged during the trip.
- Bring enough cash in case some places do not accept credit cards or other forms of payment.
- Be sure to carry your passport or a copy of your passport with you at all times when traveling around Ghana if needed. However, it is best to keep it stored securely in your hotel safe or another secure location while not in use.
- Roads in Ghana range from paved highways to unpaved backroads, so it is important to know what type of terrain you will be dealing with during your travels. In addition, traffic in Ghana can often be congested, so it is important to plan ahead and account for delays.
- Certain practices foreign visitors may engage in are frowned upon within the country. As such being aware of these cultural nuances will help ensure safe passage throughout the stay for any visitor going for an excursion in Ghana. The cahaperone will make you aware of these as much as possible.
